He was born in Kütahya in 1914. He graduated from Bursa High School (1934), İstanbul University Faculty of Letters (1938), and Faculty of Education – Department of History of Art. He is an expert on the history of Turkish Art. He had his Ph D on Turkish Art in Germany and Australia. He became a professor in 1960.
