Professor Suna Kili is Professor of Political Science in the Department of Political Science and International Relations, Boğaziçi University, Istanbul, Turkey. She received her B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. degrees in Political Science from Bryn Mawr College, U.S.A. She also carried on research work and post-doctoral research work, respectively, at the University of California-Berkeley, the London School of Economics and Political Science, Columbia, and Princeton Universities. She has been a visiting professor and lectured at about forty-five Universities and Colleges outside of her own country including the Universities of California-Berkeley and Los Angeles, Pennsylvania, Bryn Mawr and Haverford Colleges, Sorbonne, San Salvador and John F.Kennedy (Argentina), Vienna, Salzburg, Oslo, Copenhagen, Oxford, London, Durham, Kent; Australian National University, Melbourne, Adelaide; Capetown, Johannesburg, Stellenbosch, Durban, Lagos (Nigeria), Oldenburg, Helsinki,

Chile(Santiago), Peru, Erasmus University Rotterdam, Groningen; Göteborg and Uppsala.
