

Prof. Dr. Tahsin Kesici

Born on March 1, 1938, in Ermenek, Konya, Tahsin Kesici completed his primary and secondary studies in the same city. He graduated from Konya High School in 1956 and Ankara University Faculty of Agriculture in 1960. Awarded with a scholarship, Prof. Dr. Tahsin Kesici had opportunities to carry out research in Italy for eight months between the years of 1960-61. He also participated in vocational courses following his graduation.

Awarded with an assistantship at Ankara University, Faculty of Agriculture by the department of Animal Science, Mr. Kesici completed his doctoral studies in 1964. He then completed his military service in 1967. Upon his return, he continued his profession in the department of Genetics and Statistics at Faculty of Agriculture. Later on, he completed his two-year post-doctoral study in The Federal Republic of Germany in 1971.

Awarded with a position as Associate Professor in 1971, Mr. Kesici worked as the head of Genetics and Statistics department.

Having awarded with a professorship in 1979, Mr. Tahsin Kesici worked as a deputy dean in Ankara University, Faculty of Agriculture between 1980 and 1984, as the Dean between the years of 1984-87, and as the Vice-President of Ankara University between 1987 and 1992. He also had participated in the steering board between 1993 and 2002. Mr. Tahsin Kesici was also appointed to the Head of Informatics Department and as the Head of Foreign Languages School, Rectorate affiliates.

Prof. Dr. Tahsin Kesici then became a member of Higher Education Council in July, 2002. At this juncture, he was appointed to TOBB University of Technology and Economics as the Rector in September, 2004.

Prof. Dr. Tahsin Kesici is competent in two foreign languages: German and Italian. He also has enough background to follow scientific publications in English and French. He is married with two children.
