

## **C.V. OF PROF. DR. ESAT ARSLAN**

Esat Arslan was born in Istanbul. Finishing his primary and secondary school in Istanbul and his undergraduate education in Ankara , he completed his post graduate study on "Defence Sciences, Public Management" branches. Later than he was the holder of a doctorate degree (Ph.D.) on the branche of "History of Turkish Republic" from Ankara University. Working at Damascus Embassy as a military attaché between 1988 to 1990, he had associate professor degree after coming back Turkey. Prof. Dr. Esat Arslan who has been at the assuming at Bilkent University for ten years as the History of Turkish Republic Coordinator, was rewarded with the "Medal of Merit of Turkish Republic Government" on March 29, 2000. With regard to his contribution on Armenian studies, he was rewarded with the "Armenian Special Reward" by ASAM (Center of Eurasia Strategical Studies), NGO, in 2002. Untill 2003, he had been giving the lectures of "Turkish-Armenian Relationships from Ottoman Empire up to Today and Institutionalization" and "Ottoman Paleography" at Ankara University. He gave the lecture of "War History I-II" at the Turkish War Academy, in Ankara at post-graduate level "The Middle East in the International Foreign Policy" at the Institute of Defence Sciences; the lecture of "History of Turkish Republic I-II" at under graduate study level at Bilkent University. He participated in International Relations Department at Cag University as a scholar in 2005. He promoted to Political History Professor at International Relations Department at the same University. Now, he is head of this department. At the mean time, Prof. Dr. Esat ARSLAN has been given lectures of “ History of Middle East”, “History of Turkish Republic”, International Relations I-II and “ Turkish Contemporary Politics” at Çağ University. He has carried out the member of the executive council of Turkish Commission of International Military History and the member of History Research of Turkish Grand National Assembly. In the mean time, he is President of Mediterranean Researches Institute.

Esat ARSLAN, who has been studying at Syrian Government Archives, Iran Foreign Affairs Document Archives, Washington National Archives Department and Library of Congress in USA, he worked, in “Diplomatic” annex Financial Forum Turkish daily newspaper, in 2001-2003 as a foreign policy analyst . Having his four books printed, in the recent times, he has been writting the monthly articles in 2023 magazine, as a foreign policy strategist. In the mean time, he has participated in both national and international television programmes as a foreign politics interpreter. In addition to these, he has five books and many articles with regard to neighbour countries, international relationships and historical views publishing on many scientific journals and newspapers. Last book, “The Armenian Rebellion at Van” was published in August 2006. He speaks English, Arabic and Persian .
