### **Dr Andrew Mango**

Born in Istanbul in 1926.

Studied at English High School, Istanbul, and at the School of Oriental Studies, University of London. Ph.D. (Classical Persian) 1955.

Joined the BBC External Services (now World Service) in 1947. In charge of broadcasts in Turkish 1958-1972. Retired in 1986 as Head of South European and French Language Services.

Now engaged full-time in consultancy, academic research and journalistic coverage of Turkey. Author of biography of Atatürk, published by John Murray, London, September 1999 (2<sup>nd</sup> paperback edition, February 2004), Overlook Press, New York, April 2000 (paperback 2002), and in Turkish translation by Sabah Kitapları, Istanbul, April 2000 (2<sup>nd</sup> ed. Remzi, 2004). (Earlier works: *Turkey*, 1968; *Discovering Turkey*, 1972; *Turkey: The Challenge of a New Role*, 1994, etc.) He followed this up with *The Turks Today*, which was published in August 2004 by John Murray in London and Overlook Press in New York (Turkish translation published by Remzi). His study of terrorism in Turkey, *Turkey and the War on Terror*, was published by Routledge in August 2005, in paperback and hardback, simultaneously in London and New York. The Turkish translation, *Türkiye'nin Terörle Savaşı*, was published by Doğan Kitap in October 2005.

Member of London Middle East Institute, University of London; Turkish History Foundation, Istanbul; and of editorial boards of academic publications in London, Ankara, Paris and Tel Aviv.

Decorated with the Distinguished Service (Üstün Hizmet) medal of the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the award of the Atatürk Society of America, and the Annual Education Award of the American Turkish Council. Awarded honorary Ph.D. by Middle East Technical University (ODTÜ) in Ankara.

Married. Has lived in London since 1947.
